



## Specialist Knowledge for Teaching Mathematics (SKTM) Primary Early Careers Teachers (ECTs)

This programme is designed to support the subject knowledge and pedagogical knowledge for Early Careers Teachers (ECTs) teaching and supporting the learning of primary maths, recognising the requirements of the ECF.
